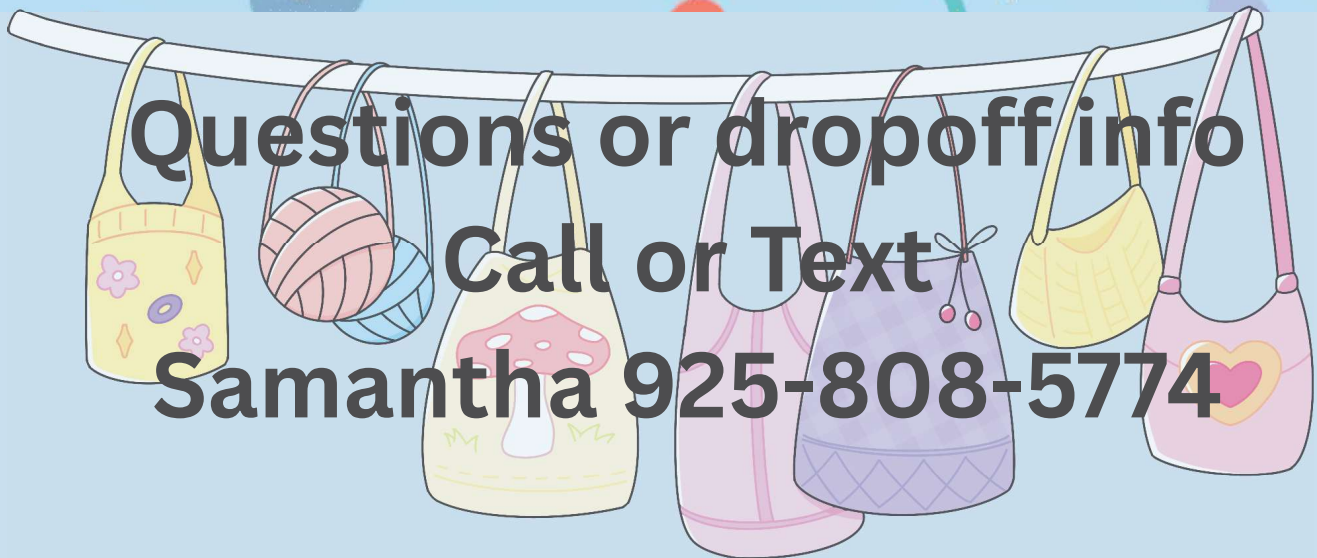

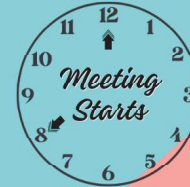

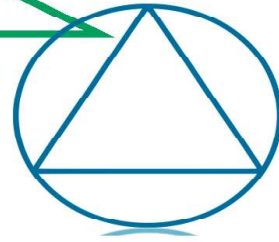

### TOPIC PRESENTATION — Home Group Online (HGOL) — Presented by James S., Crockett Group

- HGOL was presented as a financial-service platform designed for Twelve-Step groups, districts, and fellowship events.
- Founded in 2018 in Phoenix and currently based in Chicago.
- Provides financial tools intended to assist groups with banking, electronic contributions, treasurer transitions, and financial recordkeeping.

#### Services and Potential Benefits:

- Online banking access and deposit-only ATM capability.

- Multiple electronic payment options.
- Individual group codes and QR codes.
- Simplified transition between outgoing and incoming treasurers.
- Online transaction history and audit trail.
- Organizational structure intended to provide legal and administrative protections.

#### **Considerations and Limitations:**

- HGOL and payment-processing fees may collectively require approximately 2–3% of Seventh Tradition receipts.
- Coins cannot be deposited directly through the ATM system.
- Certain vendors may not accept available payment methods, requiring reimbursement procedures.
- Financial reports currently require exporting or transferring transaction data into outside software.
- The presentation noted that HGOL may be more useful for larger groups than smaller groups and referenced AA World Services literature concerning group finances.

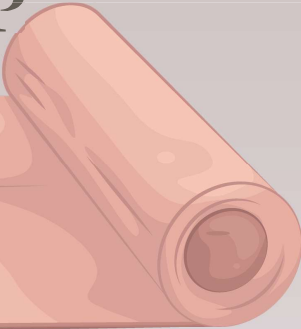

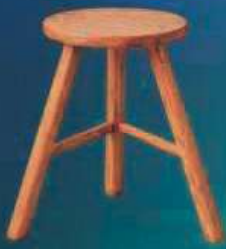

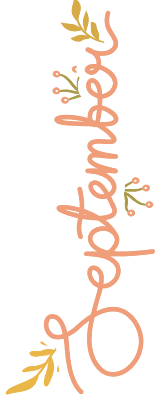
